Directions to MANCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL 134 East Middle Turnpike

Take I-84 East

Exit 63 [as you enter the ramp be in the right lane which becomes the center lane to **go straight ahead**] At end of ramp **go straight** on to **Oakland Street**

At the second traffic light **go straight** onto **Summit Street** [at the light *Sam's Fried Chicken will be on your left then* you will cross over Railroad Tracks and NOT have to stop] road curves to the right a little after the first stop sign...

You will drive by the school enter the second driveway


I-84 West
