Directions to MANCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL 134 East Middle Turnpike

Take I 84 East

Exit 63 [as you enter the ramp be in the right lane which becomes the center lane to go straight ahead] At end of ramp go straight on to Oakland Street

At the *second traffic light* **go straight** onto **Summit Street** [at the light *Sam's Fried Chicken will be on your left then* you will cross over Railroad Tracks and NOT have to stop] road curves to the right a little after the first stop sign...

You are still on Summit Street


You will drive by the school enter the second driveway
