ECI TEE TIMES ANNOUNCED; MICELI WITHDRAWS

SOUTH WINDSOR, Conn. – Tournament officials at the 12-year-old annual alumni event that pits hard-working amateurs against the post-college casual golfer has at long last, finalized its starting times with Shining Rock Golf Club, its new venue.

With a field of 12 at the most, it may seem depleted, but there certainly isn't a lack of talent, and it's definitely an outing the players look forward to every spring. "We have four out of the five champions of this tournament, playing this year," stated Marc Zirolli, ECI tournament co-chair. "We hope Mr. Gill can attend, but at the same time, we understand his commitment with work. He is well aware that there is always a place for him at the ECI."

The first starting time is at 10:30 a.m., with the subsequent times eight minutes apart, at 10:38 and 10:47. Players have the option the day of the tournament to find a nearby driving range, since an onsite facility at Shining Rock does not exist. Please arrive at the golf course an hour in advance to allow proper catching up with old friends and to offer well wishes to the Montréal Canadiens as their pursuit to bring the Cup home where it belongs, continues into the Eastern Conference Finals.

JERRY MICELI SITES UNDISCLOSED WD

Jerry Miceli, the ECI's youngest star, withdrew from tournament competition on Wednesday, May 7, but not without displaying a clear sign of disappointment. "I'm really upset that I won't be able to compete at this year's event," stated Miceli, who finished ninth in 2013. "I always look forward to playing, and feel that I can compete each and every year. Hey; some things come up; it happens, and I'm sure Marc, John and the rest of the guys understand. I'm already gearing up for a return in 2015!"

In three starts at the ECI, Miceli's best finish was tied for third in 2011 with Nick Turczak. John Dailey captured his most recent ECI title that year, finishing two better than Ken Tessier, and three ahead of Miceli and Turczak. After withdrawing in 2013, Dailey returns this year, seeking a tournament-best, fourth championship.
