Many of you remember Stan Greimann, who was the Director of the Connecticut River Estuary Regional Planning Agency (CRERPA) from 1967 to 1995. Stan is credited for starting CRERPA, the Gateway Commission, and the Estuary Transit District.

Stan was also the person who brought the leadership from all the area senior clubs together to form a Board of Directors and to apply for a grant to hire Monica Eggert as their director. That was the beginning of the Estuary Council of Seniors and your nine town regional senior center.

I spoke with Monica and she told me that Stan was her mentor. She asked for his advice frequently because he knew the Estuary towns and their needs.

Stan was particularly interested in senior transportation. Our EMOTS program takes seniors within the nine-town Estuary Region to medical outpatient appointments beyond the nine towns. It is the only affordable transportation available to seniors.

Thanks to a generous contribution from his family, we are naming our EMOTS program in his memory. From now on, it will be known as the Stan Greimann Estuary Medical Outpatient Transportation Service. I believe Stan would be very proud to have his name on this very valuable and essential senior service.
