

Day 1 Wed Feb 16, 2011 Depart New York Depart New York on British Airways overnight flight to London.

**Day 2** Thu Feb 17, 2011 London en route Arrive in London this morning where day rooms are provided to relax. Early this evening depart on British Airways overnight flight to Dar es Salaam. *Day Room: Sofitel Heathrow* 

Day 3 Fri Feb 18, 2011 Arrive Dar es Salaam - Selous (LD) This morning you are met and assisted to the local flight to Selous. Camp staff will meet you at the airstrip and transfer you to your camp to settle in for lunch. The spacious tents are luxuriously appointed, with en suite bathrooms and open air hot-water showers. Relax by the pool, or have your first afternoon game activity. There are no fences or artificial modifications to the natural fauna so animals may wander near the camp. Selous Safari Camp

Day 4 Sat Feb 19, 2011 Selous Game Reserve (BLD) The camp offers an exhilarating safari experience with game drives in open camp vehicles. The World Heritage Site of Selous (about the size of Switzerland) is one of largest areas in the world set aside for conservation. Game viewing can be absolutely amazing. More than 65% of Tanzania's elephant population is found in the Selous, making this one of the world's largest concentrations of elephant in one area. Most of the herds are small family groups led by matriarchs. The reserve is also home to an abundance of birds - plovers, herons and egrets. The African Fish Eagle is common, and you may likely see the Goliath Heron. *Selous Safari Camp* 

Day 3 Sun Feb 20, 2011 Selous Game Reserve (BLD) Enjoy morning and afternoon game activities. Selous is also home to the world's largest population of buffalo. You will likely find wildebeest, the brindled gnu, hartebeest and impala, and perhaps eland and bushbuck. While rare, you might spot a solitary black rhino, and if lucky see the Greater Kudu and sable antelope. Hippos, in the water most of the day, may come out at night to graze and can roam for wide distances. Selous Safari Camp

Day 4 Mon Feb 21, 2011 Selous – Arusha – Gibbs Farm (BLD) Transfer to the airstrip for your local flight to Arusha. Upon afternoon arrival, you will be met by private vehicles for your ride into the countryside, passing villages and plantations. Reaching Karatu, turn off for Gibbs Farm. Arrive in time to freshen up before dinner. *Gibbs Farm* 

Day 5 Tue Feb 22, 2011 Ngorongoro Crater - Gibbs Farm (BLD) Your private safari vehicle takes you on a breathtaking day riding up into the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Stop for a view and then continue your ride descending 2000ft to the crater floor below. Ngorongoro Crater is the world's largest intact volcanic caldera and is also one of the seven natural wonders of the world. Ngorongoro is believed to support the largest density of predators in Africa - with almost 100 lion at last count. Spotted hyenas are also resident. The endangered black rhino is present in the crater and can sometimes be spotted on the open grasslands in the daytime - unusual when you consider the black rhino is a nocturnal feeder. The elephant population in the crater is all old males, so you will probably see some with incredibly long tusks. Herds of wildebeest and zebra graze on the open grassland. The hippo pool can be quite entertaining – when the hippos are in the mood to surface. Return to your lodge in the afternoon. Gibbs Farm

Day 6 Wed Feb 23, 2011 Gibbs Farm – Southern Serengeti (BLD) Depart in your safari vehicle leaving the highlands. Between December and May, the wildebeest lives in the volcanic plains near Ngorongoro. Here the calves are born and get their best chance for survival. You'll begin viewing game as you approach your camp in the southern Serengeti. Secluded among rocky outcrops, Kusini Tented Camp blends into the environment. Arrive for lunch. Each tent (attended by a personal butler) features en suite bathrooms with showers, and has a terrace overlooking the Serengeti plains. This afternoon, get ready for an amazing experience as you game drive in the Southern Serengeti with your camp guide in the camp's custom open 4x4 vehicles. *Kusini Tented Camp* 



**Day 7 Thu Feb 24, 2011 Kusini-Southern Serengeti (BLD)** Enjoy morning and afternoon game drives in the predator-rich plains of the Southern Serengeti. The expanse of the plains spread out around you is awesome. Game viewing here is superb year round with plains game, big cats and hundreds of bird species. *Kusini Tented Camp* 

Day 8 Fri Feb 25, 2011 Southern Serengeti-Kilimanjaro-Nairobi-Depart (BLD) Have your last game viewing en route to the airstrip. Depart on your light aircraft transfer to Kilimanjaro where you connect on your light aircraft flight to Nairobi. On arrival, you will be met and transferred to a private lounge to freshen up. Later transfer to dinner and to the airport for your overnight flight to London.

**Day 9** Sat Feb 26, 2011 London – Arrive New York Arrive at Heathrow and connect to the British Airways flight to New York, arriving home this afternoon.
