

MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
LISBON TOWN HALL
MONDAY, MAY 14, 2018
6:30 P.M.

The Town of Lisbon Board of Selectmen held a public hearing on Monday, May 14, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in the Lisbon Town Hall, 1 Newent Road, Lisbon, Connecticut 06351 for the following purpose:

1. To consider an application by the Lisbon Historical Society for the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Program.

Thomas W. Sparkman, First Selectman opened the public hearing at 6:30 p.m. Selectman Robert Browne and the following members of the Historical Society were also present: Paula Adams, President; Marcia Shafer, Town Historian; Kenneth Mahler, Treasurer, and Bill Champagne, Consultant.

On behalf of the Historical Society, Mr. Champagne explained that the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Program is a tax credit program funded by donations of corporate and other entities, at a 100% tax credit. The funding is for energy related work up to \$150,000 which he noted is Lisbon's request.

Mr. Sparkman called on anyone in favor of the application by the Lisbon Historical Society to participate in the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Program to speak first.

Kenneth Mahler, 72 Bushnell Road, stated, that there is zero cost to the town to participate.

No one else spoke in favor of the request.

Mr. Sparkman then called for anyone in opposition to the request to speak next.

No one spoke in opposition to the request.

Mr. Sparkman closed the public hearing at 6:33 p.m.
