#### Recreation

Lisbon Meadows Park, at 37 South Burnham Highway (Route 169) consists of 59 acres with trails, tennis court, baseball and soccer fields. It is also home to the Lisbon Farmers Market, held seasonally from late June through late September. Lisbon has a public boat launch to the Shetucket River and a 1,000 foot bike-way located on 26 acres of town property just off of the road into the property at 435 South Burnham Highway. The Trail Committee is working on walking trails on town owned property at the Burnham Tavern (Kimball Road trail entrance) and at 78 Kendall Road.

Recreation activities (field scheduling, youth and adult sports programs and bus trips) are under the direction of the Lisbon Recreation Committee.
