Acceptable and Non-Acceptable items are listed below.

## **Acceptable Items**

(keep different items seperate at curb)

Furniture: Springs removed, especially from sleeper sours

Appliances: (2 per household) Boors must be removed

from refrigerators and freezers.

Leaves: in large 30 gallon brown paper leaf bags.

An plastic bugs.

Old Wood & Pallets:

(no longer than 3 feet in length)

Other Metal Items:

(must be separated from wood and furniture)

Automobile Tires:

(no truck or larger tires accepted)

## **Items NOT Accepted**

(These items will not be picked-up )

XII: Refuse, Recyclables, Rubble

(stone, concrete, brick, construction debris)

XO: Household Hazardous Waste

XO: Car Parts, Auto Batteries, or Antifroeze: (residents may take those items to the Williamntic W. Paper's Recording Site

on Roode Road in Plainfield).

XO: Propage Tanks, or 55 feellon Brums

XO: Contractor, Business, or Industrial debris

X0: Electronics - TVs, Computers, etc.
