Society Secretary, Kim Sperry will lead a walk from the Senior Center to the Newent Congregational Church and discuss the "Old Lee Road" before boarding a bus to transport the group to the Preston Hydro Electric Plant on the Quinebaug River. The plant is now more than 100 years old. There, a plant manager from GDF Suez, owner of the plant, will conduct a tour of the outside of the facility, and explore the wonder of the falls. Society Treasurer Ken Mahler will use the dam's overlook to discuss the 1838 construction of the Bundy Hill Rail Road Tunnel, the oldest active rail tunnel in America. Town Historian Marcia Shafer will be available to help with questions and additional facts. Ken will have binoculars, but bring your own if you have them. After ample time at the Hydro plant we will return to town center and member Sharon Gabiga will lead a tour of the 1810 John Bishop House.
