## WHERE?

Acceptable items will be picked up at curbside. All items must be at the curb by 7 a.m. on June 4, 2018

## WHAT?

Acceptable and Non-Acceptable items are listed below.

## **Acceptable Items**

(keep different items seperate at curb)

Springs removed, especially from sleeper sofas

**Furniture:** 

**Appliances:** (2 per household) Doors must be removed

from refrigerators and freezers.

Leaves: in large 30 gallon brown paper leaf bags.

No plastic bags.

Old Wood

& Pallets: (no longer than 3 feet in length)

Other Metal

Items:

(must be separated from wood and furniture)

Automobile

Tires:

(no truck or larger fires accepted)

## **Items NOT Accepted**

(These items will not be picked-up)

NO: Refuse, Recyclables, Rubble

(stone, concrete, brick, construction debris)

NO: Household Hazardous Waste

Car Parts, Auto Batteries, or Antifreeze: (residents may take

these items to the Willimantic W. Paper's Recycling Site

on Roode Road in Plainfield).

Propane Tanks, or 55 Gallon Drums

Contractor, Business, or Industrial debris

NO: Electronics - TVs. Computers, etc.

Brush - Brush will not be accepted and chipped at curbside this year for safety of Lisbon's highway crew. Instead, during the 2 week Spring Gean-up period, residents may bring their brush to the Lisbon Public Works garage located at 186 River Road (Route 12) between the hours of 6 a.m. and 2 p.m. Monday through Friday. (Call Public Works at 201-0355 to obtain chipped brush after spring clean-up)
