

May Tip: Growing Time

Temperatures are rising, flowers are blooming and your lawn is growing! May is a great month to help prevent weeds.

Watering

A good deep watering one or two times a week will be sufficient for your lawn. Frequent and shallow watering may cause your roots to remain shallow which makes your lawn dependent on frequent watering.

Mowing

The hotter the weather, the more helpful it is to mow at the second to the highest setting (2 1/2 to 3 inches long). This helps to conserve water, strengthen the root system, and help crowd out potential weeds.

Weeds

In May, the weeds in your lawn are still mostly perennials such as Dandelions, Thistle or Mallow. However, there is a continually increasing number of annual weeds, so think about treating.

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
